

## **2010 Playoffs**

### **U10 Division**

**All 5 teams in an "A" Division playoff.**

#### **Series 1**

**4<sup>th</sup> place vs 5<sup>th</sup> place – two game series. First team to reach three points. The first game of the series can end in a tie. The second game must have a winner. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

#### **Series 2**

**2<sup>nd</sup> place vs 3<sup>rd</sup> place – two game series. First team to reach three points. The first game of the series can end in a tie. The second game must have a winner. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

**1<sup>st</sup> place vs Winner of Series 1 - two game series. First team to reach three points. The first game of the series can end in a tie. The second game must have a winner. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

#### **Series 4**

**Winner of Series 2 vs Winner of Series 3 - two game series. First team to reach three points. The first game of the series can end in a tie. The second game must have a winner. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

## **U12A Playoffs**

**1<sup>st</sup> place vs 2<sup>nd</sup> place – Best of 5 series the first team to win 3 games becomes the U12A champions. No game can end in a tie. If the game is tied then it will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

## **U12B Playoffs**

**Three teams in a round robin series. No game can end in a tie. If the game is tied then it will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time. The First place team after the round robin will go directly to he Finals. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will play in the Semi Finals with the winner advancing to the Finals.**

## **U12C Playoffs**

**Three teams in a round robin series. No game can end in a tie. If the game is tied then it will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time. The First place team after the round robin will go directly to he Finals. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams will play in the Semi Finals with the winner advancing to the Finals.**

## **U14B Playoffs**

**Top four teams in the “B” Division of U14.**

### **Series 1**

**1<sup>st</sup> place vs 4<sup>th</sup> place - two game series. First team to reach three points. The first game of the series can end in a tie. The second game must have a winner. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

## **Game 3**

**Winner of Game 2 vs 3<sup>rd</sup> place – Winner goes to the semi finals. Loser plays for 5<sup>th</sup> place. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

## **Game 4**

**Loser of Game 1 vs Winner of Game 3 – Winner goes to the finals. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

## **Finals**

**Winner of Game 1 vs Winner of Game 4 - If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. If the game is still tied the teams will alternate shooters until one team scores and the other doesn't. You must use every one of your shooters before you can use another player a second time.**

### **Game 4**

**Winner of Game 2 vs Winner of Game 3 – Winner goes to the finals. If the two teams are tied then they will go to a 3 player shootout. ### **Finals**
